This is an educational performance opportunity where the dancers perform their dance and then return to the stage, along with all performers in their session, to receive feedback from the adjudicator.

Volunteers Needed

We require a few backstage volunteers in order to chaperone dancers as they warm-up, ensure they have their proper hair and costume, assist with any quick changes, etc. <u>All non-volunteer parents will get</u> their dancer settled in and checked in at the "backstage" area (signs to be posted) and then proceed to the theatre area if staying to watch.

Costumes, Hair & Makeup

KDFA Dance Schedule

Dancers should arrive <u>at least</u> 45 minutes prior to the start time of their session with hair and makeup already done. Classes need to be together, ready, and warmed-up 30 minutes prior to their session start time and will remain near the stage immediately after their performance until the completion of the on-stage adjudication for their session. Once their adjudication is complete dancers are free to leave or to join their families in the audience.
