

# 2024 Year-End Recital Information for Families

Please read through the detailed information carefully. It should provide the answers to any of your recital related questions. <u>IMPORTANT:</u> To provide enough audience capacity we are running two different recitals (each with two showtimes) this year. Please pay extra attention when reviewing schedules and buying tickets. All events will take place at the Beaver Brae Theatre (use the east side entrance).

## REHEARSALS - Thursday, May 9 & Friday, May 10

Dress & Tech Rehearsal - Thursday, May 9 & Friday, May 10 - 5:00 pm to 9:00 pm - Beaver Brae Theatre

- Dress rehearsal is an opportunity to practice the performances in costume and on stage with lighting and tech cues before the actual show. This ensures the show runs smoothly on the technical side and also helps the performers to be more comfortable and confident at the actual performance.
- Attendance is mandatory. Please see the chart below for the schedule including arrival and pickup times.
- To reduce the time commitment, dress rehearsal runs in an age-based order rather than show order. *Note:* Primary through Senior ballet classes will participate in both dress rehearsals as we put together the production of "Peter & the Wolf". All other classes have rehearsal on one night only.
- Dancers will be able to sit and watch other groups perform at dress rehearsal. For safety reasons and to limit distractions, volunteers and dancers will be the only ones allowed in the theatre for rehearsal.

# PERFORMANCES - Saturday, May 11

- Please see the chart below for the schedule including arrival and pickup times.
- Parents/guardians will check their dancer in with the volunteers upon arrival and will return to sign out their dancer at the end of the show. The backstage dressing rooms are limited to dancers and volunteers only.
   Please help us maintain the safety of the dancers by following our procedures.
- Some snacks and activities are provided backstage. Dancers are encouraged to bring their own snacks (no nuts please!), a water bottle, and can bring books or other items to help pass the time.

#### **Creative Movement & Dance Foundations & Ensemble**

Morning Shows - Saturday, May 11 - Shows at 10:00 am & 11:00 am - Beaver Brae Theatre

- All Creative Movement, Creative Movement & Tap, and Dance Foundations level classes (plus a few of the Ensemble routines) participate in <u>both</u> morning showtimes.
- Performers will remain in the backstage areas for the length of the show and in between shows. Show run time is 40 minutes and there will be just enough time between shows for an audience changeover.

#### Primary, Junior, Intermediate, Senior & Ensemble

Matinee & Evening Shows - Saturday, May 11 - Shows at 1:30 pm & 6:30 pm - Beaver Brae Theatre

- All Primary through Senior classes participate in <u>both</u> showtimes. Run time is approximately 90 minutes with a short intermission while we clear the set pieces from the ballet production "Peter & the Wolf".
- Performers will remain in the backstage areas for the length of each show. Dancers will return to the stage for the curtain call at the end of the show. *Note:* Ballet dancers that only perform in "Peter & the Wolf" have the option to be picked up during the intermission or to join their family in the audience for the second half of the show (if a ticket was purchased for them).

#### **Tickets**

It is strongly recommended that dance families take advantage of priority online sales. Capacity is limited in the theatre and these performances typically sell-out. Tickets are general admission and can be purchased online in advance at <u>danceworkskenora.com</u>. Doors open 20 minutes before showtime. Children under age 1 do not require a ticket but need to be seated on their caregiver's lap for the show.

Each family will receive a priority code, sent to the primary account contact, that allows for the purchase of up to 4 tickets (or 6 tickets for families with multiple dancers). Priority access will be active from Tuesday, April 30 at noon until Saturday, May 4 at noon. Open ticket sales for unclaimed priority tickets and any remaining tickets will begin on May 4 at noon and run until Friday, May 10 at midnight on a first come, first served basis. Tickets at the door (cash only) as available.

### Recital Video - Download & Streaming

The recital will be professionally filmed and will be available for streaming (\$20) or download (\$35), through the online ticketing site, from May 24 at 5:00pm to June 9 at 12 midnight. Reminder: Our all-inclusive pricing for 2024 includes one digital download for each dancer! Coupon codes for your free download will be sent to the primary account contact once the video is available online.

#### Costumes

<u>Dancers will return their costume(s) to the studio during the dates of May 13 to 16 from 3:30 pm to 6:30 pm.</u>

A costume replacement fee of \$90 will be charged to your account if the costume is lost, damaged, or is not returned during these dates.

#### **Volunteers Needed!**

These events are only possible with the assistance of volunteers. Thank you in advance to those who volunteer your time and energy to ensure these events run smoothly and safely for everyone involved. If you are volunteering as a backstage supervisor, you are able to watch your dancer perform from the wings.
